Number of grades in each subject area

Minimum of 9 grades per grading period per subject: Reading, Other Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies

Categories of assignments

Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies:

Classwork – grade levels determine definition

Tests/Projects – grade levels determine definition

Other Language Arts

Classwork

Spelling tests

Language tests and major writings

Weighting of categories

Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies:

Classwork 75%

Tests/Projects 25%

Other Language Arts

Classwork 50%

Spelling tests 20%

Language tests and major writings 30%

Reassessment plan

A student shall be allowed one opportunity to redo a classwork assignment, test, or project for which the student received a failing grade (69 or below). An average score of the original grade and the redo grade will be recorded.

Late work policy to support the mastery of designated District objectives or TEKS

Teachers shall take no more than 10 points off the first day for late classwork/projects. Each subsequent late day will result in up to a 5 point daily deduction. Late classwork/projects will not be accepted after 3 days.

No minimum grade policy to be established
