Dear Parents,

At the start of the 2007-08 school year, Gregg will follow new guidelines for daily student dress code. Students will be required to adhere to the prescribed uniform policy. The new uniform requirement is part of the school's vision to provide a positive academic learning environment and safe educational climate for our students, teachers and parents.

General Guidelines

All students will be required to wear the school uniform with the following exceptions:

- -Individual Picture Day ; Group Picture Day - appropriate clothing is required
- -Go Texan Day (mid-winter); western clothing is allowed
- -Awards Day or Special Programs – appropriate clothing is requires
- -Field Trips that require special dress
- -Student are not allowed to wear blue jeans unless part of a costume or field trips

Tops- polo shirts, t-shirts, blouses, or sweatshirts

Shirts/Tops: (Color) **RED ONLY**

- All Shirts/Tops must be worn tucked in at the waist line
- Long or short sleeve Red shirts, blouses or polo style shirts are acceptable wear
- Tank tops, muscle/sleeveless shirts, shirts with logos or pictures or not permitted

Bottoms- pants, shorts, Capri pants or skirts

Pants/Bottoms: (Color) **KHAKI ONLY**

- Skirts, skorts, jumpers and shorts are acceptable worn at knee length
- All Pants must be appropriately sized with a fitted belt worn at the waist line
- Spandex or other stretchy material is not allowed

Shoes

- Shoes must be closed-toe and closed-heeled (for example, tennis shoes).
- For safety reasons, platform shoes, heels, combat boots, ,or backless shoes (including clogs, house shoes, sandals, open-toed shoes, flip-flop shoes) are NOT allowed.
- Shoes must be secured (tied) at all times and worn with socks.
- On days with physical education students should wear athletic or tennis shoes.
- Any clothing or jewelry items that distract from the learning environment are unacceptable

Additional Dress and Grooming Regulations

- No make up
- Body piercing (other than ears for girls), must remain empty while at school.
- Any clothing or jewelry items that distract from the learning environment are unacceptable

The BCS Uniform Policy will be strictly enforced. Non-compliance may result in more serious disciplinary actions up to and including suspension based on HISD's Student Code of Conduct. *Dress code violation is a Level II infraction: repeated violations are Level III.* We need you help in making this work. Parents influence a student's attitude about wearing uniforms. By supporting this policy and enforcing what is worn to school you help keep them safe.
