





<p><b>Reading/Language Arts</b></p> 	<p>This week in literature, students will learn to identify important facts or details in texts read aloud and independently. Students will also learn to recognize and use punctuation marks at the end of declarative, exclamatory, and interrogative sentences. Another new spelling list this week!</p>
